ithout warning, Emily's 2-year-old daughter, Kenny, faced a life-threatening medical emergency. After weeks of what seemed like a bad virus, Kenny suddenly lost consciousness in her mother's arms. Emily immediately called 911 and waited anxiously for the paramedics to arrive.

Thanks to the generous support of donors like you, UPMC Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh was equipped to handle a critical case like this.

At the hospital, doctors discovered a 2-centimeter tumor on Kenny's heart. They worked around the clock to remove it, but it had broken apart, causing her to have three strokes. Nearly every part of her body was affected by this. She required immediate, intensive care.

Kenny was placed on life support. She faced paralysis, unconsciousness, and kidney failure. But the medical staff's expertise saved her life in these darkest moments.

Over the following weeks, Kenny gradually improved. She had nine additional surgeries to restore limb function. And despite initial fears that she would have to have her legs amputated, the skilled Orthopaedic team at UPMC Children's helped her recover.

Dr. Olivieri's innovative work focuses on improving diagnostic capabilities and treatment approaches for children with congenital heart issues. Her research, made possible by the continued generosity of supporters like you, aims to enhance patients' outcomes and quality of life from childhood through adulthood.

One of Dr. Olivieri's most exciting projects involves developing 3D-printed bioresorbable materials for heart repairs that grow with the child.
